

Emergency Measures in the Event of Natural Disasters

(Revised Edition)

Osaka Municipal Shinmorishoji Elementary School

Starting May 29, 2026, with the implementation of the Japan Meteorological Agency's new disaster prevention weather information, a new **"Danger Warning"** (Kiken Keiho)—which indicates a higher necessity for evacuation—has been introduced between the conventional "Warning" (Keiho) and "Emergency Warning" (Tokubetsu Keiho). To ensure the safety of our students, emergency school closures will be implemented as outlined below. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

Criteria for Emergency School Closures

School will be temporarily closed if any of the following types or scales of disasters occur **as of 7:00 AM**, or **between 7:00 AM and the start of school hours**.

No.	Criteria for Emergency Closure	Notes / Verification Methods
1	ISSUED BY JAPAN METEOROLOGICAL AGENCY (JMA) When a Storm Warning , Snowstorm Warning , Danger Warning* , or Emergency Warning is issued.	* The "Danger Warning" here excludes river flooding. Please check Criterion 2 below for river flooding information.
2	ISSUED BY OSAKA CITY When Alert Level 3 (Evacuation of the Elderly, etc.) or Alert Level 4 (Evacuation of All) is issued.	Applies if the evacuation alert targets any region in Asahi Ward with a threat of flood damage due to river flooding. Evacuation alerts will be displayed on the top banner of the Osaka City official website.
3	EARTHQUAKE When an earthquake with a seismic intensity of 5-lower (Shindo 5-weak) or higher occurs in any area of Osaka City.	Based on seismic information provided by the Japan Meteorological Agency (JMA).

【 Information Gathering During Disasters 】

When evacuation alerts are issued, notifications will be broadcast via Emergency Alert Emails (Area Mail) and local community disaster prevention speakers. For detailed information, please check the Osaka City official website, official social media accounts (X, LINE), and "Osaka Disaster Prevention Net" (Oosaka Bousai Net) at any time.
